Now we have to take the positives out of this weekend for the next race in France. If we can show the same kind of pace that we did here in practice and get a good grid position then I'm sure we can look forward to much better at Le Mans.

Fausto Gresini – TEAM MANAGER:

Shanghai is a fast track and that hasn't helped us. With Shinya we have worked well all weekend but Alex had trouble in certain sections of the track that we didn't manage to solve. Shinya is disappointed but it is important that he is taking small steps forward. Now we go to France looking to continue that improvement but we need to speed it up. We should have some new stuff at Le Mans and I think we can look forward to a good race there.
